



STUDENT SHARED APARTMENT

DESCRIPTION

A Student Shared Apartment is a great way to have an authentic, independent living experience in the city. Students have their own bedroom and will share common areas like bathrooms and kitchen with other students. Most apartments have 2 to 8 tenants, so there may be other international students living in the same place, although this is not guaranteed.

ROOM OPTIONS

When selecting a Student Shared Apartment, students looking can choose between 2 room options. Here are the different options to select from:

<u>SINGLE ROOM</u>: The single rooms have a single bed. The windows typically face the street and the desk will always be within the room.

<u>DOUBLE ROOM</u>: The double rooms either one queen-size bed or two twin beds (depending on relationship of students). The windows typically face the street and the desk will always be within the room. Double rooms are for two students booking together.

LOCATION OF APARTMENTS

Our Student Shared Apartments are located in the best and safest neighborhoods in the city and they will always be within a maximum commute of 35 minutes from the school. Example neighborhoods are Guindalera, Chamberí, Legazpi, Cuatro Caminos, Tetuán, and Chamartín. They will always be close to public transportation (subway or bus) to make your daily commute as easy as possible.

WHO WILL STUDENTS LIVE WITH?

In the Student Shared Apartment students will live with other students, both Expanish and non-Expanish students who are mostly between the ages of 18 and 39 although there is no maximum age restriction. Apartments usually range from two to eight people, depending on the size of the apartment. Apartment mates may be of any sex, so there are no gender-specific apartments.

CHECK-IN AND CHECK-OUT

- Check-in on Sundays between 8 am and 8 pm
- Check-out on Saturdays before 12 pm (noon)

Check-ins later than 8 pm are possible on a case-by-case basis. If possible, there is a late check-in fee of 25€ paid in cash to the school staff on the following open day.

WHAT'S INCLUDED

In the bedroom

- Bed
- Closet/space to store clothes
- Gas or electrical heating
- Window
- Sheets and towels

In common areas

- WiFi (throughout the apartment)
- Washing machine
- Refrigerator with freezer
- Oven and/or stove top
- Microwave
- Silverware and cooking utensils

WHAT'S NOT INCLUDED

- Hair dryer
- Personal hygiene products and home cleaning products
- A/C
- Clothes dryer





NOTES

- There is a maximum of 4 students per shared bathroom.
- Weekly cleaning is of the common areas.
- Students are responsible for cleaning and changing their own sheets and towels.
- Some apartments may not have an elevator, only stairs. This is a common feature in Madrid city apartments.
- Students will receive a key to the apartment upon arrival. Each bedroom has a lock.
- Housing assignments are sent out 2 weeks before arrival.
