IMPORTANT NOTES:

• **Visas** - All students with long-term programs will need a student visa for their stay. As part of the application process, Expanish will provide a visa letter upon payment of the program. We recommend that all visa applications are started 2 months before departure.

• Additional Visa Documents - The courier fee covers the cost to send via courier the initial visa letter to the student. Any additional documents sent (changes to dates, etc.) will incur a fee of 90€ each time.

• **Spanish Levels** - Students selecting the 12-Month Package should have a level of A1 or complete beginner at the beginning of the program. Students selecting the 6-Month Package should have a level of B1 or lower at the beginning of the program.

• **Materials Fee** - Students will be responsible for the materials fee of 30€ to be paid on-site, which is not included in the above pricing. Each time they move through levels and receive a new book a new fee of 30€ is required.

• **Attendance** - Attendance is vitally important and will be tracked. Students must attend 80% of classes in order to stay at their level.

• **Legal Status for Work** - Those with a student visa and staying more than 180 days in Spain may work part time hours during their program. The work permit typically takes 4 to 5 months to finish all the steps.

• **Vacations** - Vacation/holidays may be taken at any time but need to be arranged 2 weeks in advance.

• **Cancellation Policy** - These packages have separate cancellation policies:

- To cancel or end studies at the school, the student is required to return the original certificate of studies document (for cancellation with official denial of visa document).
- Cancellation with the official denial of student visa document:
 - If the cancellation is made at least 15 days before the program start date, the school will return the full value of the course minus a 250€ cancellation fee.
 - If the cancellation is made less than 15 days before the program start date, the school will return the full value of the course minus 25% of the total amount paid as a cancellation fee.

• Cancellations without the official denial of student visa document:

There is no refund of program fees nor can the program be transferred to another person.
