## **GROUP COURSE - 30 LESSONS** Factsheet 2024

#### DESCRIPTION

The Group Course of 30 lessons is our most intensive group course, perfect for students who want to have extra time in a group setting to practice their language skills. Students will participate in the same groups as the 20 lessons option, but have an additional 2 hours of class each day for extra class time.

#### THE BENEFIT OF ADDITIONAL GROUP LESSONS

Students will have an additional 2 hours of group lessons each day in order to review and practice their communication skills. Rather than learning new grammar and advancing faster through our level system, this course is designed to provide students with extra time with a professor in a classroom environment. More class time means that fluidity and use of language is increased, allowing students to feel more confident while using Spanish.
