DESCRIPTION

The Group Course of 30 lessons is our most intensive group course, perfect for students who want to have extra time in a group setting to practice their language skills. Students will participate in the regular groups of Intensive Spanish 20, but have an additional 2 hours of class each day for extra class time.

- For high beginners to advanced students (not for complete beginners)
- Minimum of 1 week, maximum of 44 weeks
- Average students in class:
 - Low season (April to December) 6
- High season (January to March) 9
- Schedule mornings and afternoons
- 1 lesson is 50 minutes

THE BENEFIT OF ADDITIONAL GROUP LESSONS

Students will have an additional 2 hours of group lessons each day in order to review and practice their communication skills. Rather than learning new grammar and advancing faster through our levels system, this course is designed to provide students with extra time with a professor in a classroom environment. More class time means that fluidity and use of language is increased, allowing students to feel more confident while using Spanish.
